- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

 Mayor Cole called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.
- 2. <u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE –U.S. Flag and Texas Flag</u>
 Mayor Cole led everyone in the pledges.
- 3. <u>OBSERVE A MOMENT OF SILENCE/PRAYER</u>
 Mayor Cole led everyone in a moment of silence.
- 4. <u>CITIZENS TO BE HEARD (PUBLIC FORUM)</u> "At this time, comments will be taken from the audience on any subject matter that is not on the agenda. 5. <u>ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION</u>

A. Discuss/Approve/Disapprove authorization to issue requests for proposals (RFPs) for administrative services and requests for qualifications (RFQs) for engineering services related to the Community Development Block Grant - Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) grant programs administered by the Texas General Land Office (GLO).

Mayor Cole read the item for consideration and asked Council their opinion of the information reviewed. The Mayor also informed the Council this grant would be in hopes of helping with the lift stations.

Motion: A motion was made by Beverly Garis and seconded by Robert Loslin to approve the issuing of requests for proposals (RFPs) for administrative services and requests for qualifications (RFQs) for engineering services related to the Community Development Block Grant - Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) grant programs administered by the Texas General Land Office (GLO). Motion carried unanimously.

B. Discuss/Approve/Disapprove the Guaranteed Maximum Price Proposal and Basis of Price for the Fulton Fishing Pier Replacement submitted by Construction Manager, G2 Contractors, LLC.

Mayor Cole read the item for consideration and explained this proposal was received from the General Contract in charge of the pier project. There was a brief discussion regarding the guaranteed amount. Mr. Biesenbach had a question regarding the increase of the price. Mayor Cole addressed the question.

Motion: A motion was made by Robert Loflin and seconded by Beverly Garis to approve the Guaranteed Maximum Price Proposal and Basis of Price for the Fulton Fishing Pier Replacement submitted by Construction Manager, G2 Contractors, LLC. Motion carried unanimously.
