



PROCLAMATION DISASTER DECLARATION ORDER

WHEREAS, Aransas County, Texas, on the 7th day of July 2021, suffered widespread or severe property damage, and threatens injury or loss of life resulting from the severe weather and flooding, occurring in the County beginning on July 5th and continuing through July 9th 2021; and

WHEREAS, this event also caused significant damage to roads and community infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the excess flooding and water has caused a major outbreak of disease carrying pests and mosquitos posing a significant threat to public health; and

WHEREAS, Town of Fulton, Fulton, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect community assets and rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED by Mayor Kelli Cole of Fulton, Texas:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Town of Fulton pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.


Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by Town of Fulton.


Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Town of Fulton Emergency Management Plan.

That this Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
